

Final Transcripts for Graduating Students

How do I receive verification that I've graduated from Temple University?

Your official Temple University academic transcript is your verification of graduation. Although transcripts are issued by the Office of Academic Records, you request the transcript and pay the fee through the National Student Clearinghouse. You will receive email confirmation of your request and also when the transcript is mailed. For information see: <http://www.temple.edu/registrar/services.html#transcript>

Please note that no transcripts are issued or graduation verification is done for students who have Holds. Common holds:

Once I finish classes, how soon can I get a transcript?

Normally, degrees are posted to the transcripts within two - four weeks after the official graduation date (listed as Diploma Date on the Academic Calendar: http://www.temple.edu/registrar/acad_calendars.html)

I'm planning to sit for a professional exam (or going to graduate school) and need a transcript as soon as possible. What can I do to expedite the process?

The University cannot issue a transcript verifying your degree prior to the official graduation date. Complete and submit your transcript request and required fee, and check the box "Hold for degree". This will ensure your request is processed in a timely manner.

The Pennsylvania CPA exams are offered quarterly – when can I sit for the exam based on my graduation date?

PA CPA Exam Schedule	Latest Qualifying Temple Graduation
January/February	August of the previous year
April/May	January of the same year
July/August	May of the same year
October/November	August of the same year
