## **Einstein: Comments on Today's Statistics**

### **Abstract**

During early 2005 I tried to convince ASA to have a statistician write a paper on Einstein and Statistics as our contribution during the 100 anniversary of the 1905 “Golden Year” celebration. There were no takers and I was invited to give a 2006 talk at Philadelphia ASA. This is a different talk. It provides a different view of Einstein than the common biographies and uses him to explore such relevant topics as: What constitutes a very good Ph.D. dissertation; the relationship between applied and theoretical statistics; what makes a quality journal; and comments on revolutions in scientific fields. This will be a discussion talk and only a few very simple formulas will be mentioned.
